6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-13-102(a)(i)(A) and (ii)(A) and (c)  
9 is amended to read:

11 **21-13-102. Maximum rate of school district tax;**  
12 **recapture of excess; equalization of permissive levies.**

14 (a) Except as otherwise provided by law, the maximum  
15 rate of school district tax that may be levied for all  
16 school purposes, exclusive of bond interest and redemption,  
17 for any school district in any school year on each dollar of  
18 assessed valuation within the school district is as follows:

(i) In a unified school district:

(A) ~~Twenty-five (25)~~ Twenty-seven (27) mills

shall be levied for combined elementary, junior high and

high school purposes; and

(ii) In any nonunified school district consisting

of kindergarten through grade eight (8):

(A) ~~Twenty (20)~~ Twenty-two (22) mills shall

be levied for school purposes; and

(c) The revenue to be rebated under subsection (b) of

this section shall not exceed seventy-five percent (75%) of

16

the difference between the revenue received by a school

district from the mandatory levies per average daily

18

membership provided by subsection (a) of this section and

19

the statewide revenue per average daily membership from

20

~~twenty-five (25)~~ twenty-seven (27) mills, multiplied by the

21

average daily membership of the school district. Annually,

22

on or before July 15, the department using average daily

23

memberships and assessed valuations from the preceding

24

fiscal year, shall compute maximum recapture under this

25

subsection for each district and the final amount of

1 recapture computed under subsection (b) of this section for  
2 the preceding fiscal year. If any district rebated more  
3 revenue to the state during the preceding fiscal year than  
4 the maximum computed, or than the amount to be rebated under  
5 subsection (b) of this section as computed using actual data  
6 from the preceding fiscal year, the department shall rebate  
7 the excess to the district. If any district rebated less  
8 revenue to the state during the preceding fiscal year than  
9 the amount to be rebated under subsection (b) of this  
10 section, as computed using actual data from the preceding  
11 fiscal year, the district shall rebate the difference to the  
12 state.

14           **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon  
15 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as  
16 provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming  
17 Constitution.
