- (a) The state-fire-marshal-er-the chief of the fire department of each city, town, or fire district in the state of Wyoming shall investigate the cause, origin and circumstances of each fire occurring in such THE city, town, or district by IN which property ef--a--value--in excess---ef---five--hundred--dellars--(\$500-00) has been destroyed or damaged, and-shall-make-an--investigation to determine whether the fire was the result of carelessness or design. The investigation shall be commenced within-twe (2)-days,-net-including-Sunday-if--the--fire--eccurred--en that--day,--and IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE OCCURRENCE OF THE FIRE. The state fire marshal may superintend and direct the investigation if he deems it necessary.
- (b) The efficer--making-an-investigation CHIEF of a fire-occurring-in-a THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OF EACH city, town, or fire district shall notify the state fire marshal OF EVERY FIRE OCCURRING WITHIN HIS JURISDICTION ON A FORM PROVIDED BY THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL. WHENEVER THE FIRE CHIEF FINDS ANY FIRE TO BE OF SUSPICIOUS ORIGIN OR INVOLVES A DEATH OR SERIOUS INJURY, HE SHALL IMMEDIATELY NOTIFY THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL and within one (1) week of the occurrence of the fire shall furnish him a written statement of all facts relating to its cause and origin,
