1 AN ACT to amend W.S. 9-5-211 and 9-5-212 relating to con-  
 2 tributions to the Wyoming retirement system; increasing

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

6 Section 1. W.S. 9-5-211 and 9-5-212 are amended to  
 7 read:

8 9-5-211. Employees' contributions. Every employee  
 9 covered under this act shall pay into the fund five and  
 10 ~~fifty-seven~~ NINETY-EIGHT hundredths percent ~~(5.57%)~~  
 11 (5.98%) of his salary. Such payments shall be deducted

1 each pay period from employees' salaries by the chief  
2 fiscal officer of each employer.

3 9-5-212. Matching contributions by employer; con-  
4 tributions to be transferred to fund; recovery of delin-  
5 quent contributions; interest. Each employer shall pay  
6 into the fund a matching contribution equal to five and  
7 ~~fifty-seven~~ NINETY-EIGHT hundredths percent ~~(5.57%)~~  
8 (5.98%) of the salary paid to each of its employees cov-  
9 ered under the act. These matching contributions,  
10 together with the employees' contributions shall be trans-  
11 ferred and credited to the fund in a manner as directed by  
12 the board, and if the contributions are not transferred to  
13 the board when due, they may be recovered, together with  
14 interest at the rate of eight percent (8%) per annum, in  
15 an action brought for that purpose in the district court  
16 in and for the county in which the employer has its prin-  
17 cipal office or place of activity.

18 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 1979.
