NO SIGNIFICANT PERSONNEL
PERSONNEL IMPACT AT STATE LEVEL

(iii) "Life-sustaining procedure" means any medical procedure or intervention which, when applied to a qualified patient, would serve only to prolong the dying process and where in the judgment of the attending physician, death will occur whether or not the procedure or intervention is utilized. Life-sustaining procedure does not include the administration of ~~nourishment~~, medication or the performance of any medical procedure deemed necessary to provide comfort, care or to alleviate pain;
