**ADVERTISEMENT OF ESTRAYS.**

AN ACT amending and re-enacting Section 3183, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1920, relating to advertisement of estrays.

*Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

**Section 1.** Section 3183 Wyoming Compiled Statutes 1920 is hereby amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

**Section 3183.** If the Secretary of the Board of Live Stock Commissioners shall be unable to determine from the records and description who is the owner or probable owner of such stray or estrays, he shall at once cause an advertisement to be published in the newspaper in the county nearest the place where said stray was taken up, once each week, for two consecutive weeks, giving a description of said animal or animals, stating when and where the same were taken up, and giving notice that unless the same are claimed by the legal owner within ten days after the last publication of said notice, then the same shall be sold by the Board of Live Stock Commissioners for the benefit of the owner if found within the time now specified by law. Within ten days after the first publication of said notice, three copies thereof shall be posted in three public places in the vicinity of the place where said animal or animals were taken up.

**Section 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
