Original House Bill No. 112

**COUNTY LIVESTOCK INSPECTOR—AUTHORIZATION TO ISSUE
CERTIFICATE AND PERMIT**

AN ACT authorizing the County Livestock Inspector of any county, with the consent and approval of the Wyoming Live Stock and Sanitary Board, to issue a Brand Inspection Certificate and Permit to the owner transporting saddle, work, show horses or rodeo horses from county to county within the State; providing conditions under which said Certificate and Permit shall issue; and fixing a fee for granting same.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

**Certificate For Transportation of Horses From County To County—
Approval of Wyoming Live Stock and Sanitary Board—Validity of
Permit**

Section 1. With the consent and approval of the Wyoming Live Stock and Sanitary Board, the County Livestock Inspector, or any county, or authorized representative of the Wyoming Live Stock and Sanitary Board, may issue a Brand Inspection Certificate for saddle, work, show horses or rodeo horses to be transported from county to county within the State of Wyoming by the owner thereof for his personal or business use where there is no change of ownership. The inspection as required by this Act must be on a form approved by the Wyoming Live Stock and Sanitary Board and may serve as a travel permit within the State for a period not to exceed one year for the horse or horses described thereon. Such permit shall become void upon the transfer of ownership or if such horse or horses are to be removed from the State. In such instances another inspection must be made and the original certificate surrendered.

To be valid each permit must have been signed by an authorized representative of the Wyoming Live Stock and Sanitary Board, or County Livestock Inspector, and countersigned by the permit

holder. The permit must be in possession of the person in charge of the horse or horses being transported over or along any State highway and must be shown, on request, to any officer authorized to enforce the provisions of Brand Inspection laws.

Each permit must be filled out in triplicate, one copy to be forwarded to the Wyoming Live Stock and Sanitary Board, one copy to be retained by the County Livestock Inspector, or authorized representative as above mentioned, and the original to be given to the permit holder.

Fee For Certificate and Permit

Section 2. The fee for issuing such Brand Inspection Certificate and Permit shall be fifteen (.15¢) per head of such livestock.
