Any person who administers poison to any domestic animal, or exposes a poisonous substance with the intent that it shall be taken or swallowed by any domestic animal, is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment in the county jail not exceeding eighty (80) days, or by a fine not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) nor more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), or both.

Every person who overdrives, overloads, drives when overloaded. overworks, or wilfully WILLFULLY and maliciously tortures. torments, deprives of necessary sustenance, unnecessarily or cruelly beats, or wilfully WILLFULLY and maliciously and needlessly mutilates or kills, or carries in or upon any vehicle, or otherwise in a cruel or inhuman manner any animal, or causes or procures it to be done; or who, having the charge and custody of any animal, unnecessarily fails to provide it with the proper food, drink or protection from the weather, or cruelly abandons it shall upon conviction, be punished by imprisonment in the county iail-not-exceeding-one-year-or-by A fine OF not less than ten ONE HUNDRED dollars (\$100.00) nor more than one hundred FIVE THOUSAND dollars or by-both-such-fire (\$5,000.00) and MANDATORY imprisonment FOR ONE (1) YEAR. IN ADDITION: UPON SECOND CONVICTION THE SHERIFF OR HIS DEPUTY SHALL SEIZE ANY AFFECTED ANIMALS OF THE CONVICTED PERSON FOR PERMANENT CONFISCATION.
