11 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

12

13 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-4-218 is created to read:

14

15 **9-4-218. Governor's economic stability for federal**
16 **natural resource policy account created; purposes.**

2 (a) There is created within the special revenue fund
3 an account known as the "governor's economic stability for
4 federal natural resource policy account." Funds within the
5 account may be expended by the governor on behalf of the
6 state of Wyoming and its local governments, to take any of
7 the actions specified in this subsection in response to
8 federal land, water, air, mineral and other environmental
9 policies which affect the tax base of the state, economic
10 stability of the state, recreational opportunities, wildlife
11 management, private property rights, water rights or
12 leasehold rights. The governor may:

13

14 (i) Recognize and support economic development
15 opportunities;

16

17 (ii) Monitor federal natural resource issues;

18

19 (iii) Coordinate, cooperate and communicate with
20 local governments, other states and the federal government;

21

22 (iv) Assist counties with federal land use plans;

23

24 (v) Litigate only when all reasonable efforts to
25 negotiate a settlement have failed.

1

2 (b) All funds remaining in the governor's economic
3 stability for federal natural resource policy account at the
4 end of a biennium shall remain in the account to implement
5 the purposes of this section.

6

7 **Section 2.** The Wyoming legislature recognizes the
8 impact made on Wyoming's economy, custom, culture, and
9 management of natural resources within Wyoming by proposed
10 policies and decisions by federal agencies involving federal
11 natural resource management policies. The Wyoming
12 legislature desires to coordinate, cooperate and communicate
13 with the federal government and, if necessary, challenge
14 federal natural resource management policies which are
15 implemented or advanced in contravention of decisions made
16 by the United States congress or are contrary to the best
17 interests of the state of Wyoming, its local governments and
18 the property rights of its citizens.

19

20 **Section 3.** There is appropriated from the statutory
21 reserve account to the governor's economic stability for
22 federal natural resource policy account one million five
23 hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000.00) to implement the
24 purposes of this act.

25

1 **Section 4.** This act is effective July 1, 1998.
