13 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-4-218 is created to read:

- 9-4-218. Governor's economic stability for federal
- 16 natural resource policy account created; purposes.

2 There is created within the special revenue fund an account known as the "governor's economic stability for 3 federal natural resource policy account." Funds within the 4 account may be expended by the governor on behalf of the 5 state of Wyoming and its local governments, to take any of 6 7 the actions specified in this subsection in response to federal land, water, air, mineral and other environmental 8 policies which affect the tax base of the state, economic 9 stability of the state, recreational opportunities, wildlife 10 11 management, private property rights, water rights 12 leasehold rights. The governor may:

14 (i) Recognize and support economic development 15 opportunities;

17 (ii) Monitor federal natural resource issues;

19 (iii) Coordinate, cooperate and communicate with 20 local governments, other states and the federal government;

24 (v) Litigate only when all reasonable efforts to 25 negotiate a settlement have failed.

2 (b) All funds remaining in the governor's economic 3 stability for federal natural resource policy account at the 4 end of a biennium shall remain in the account to implement 5 the purposes of this section.

Section 2. The Wyoming legislature recognizes 7 impact made on Wyoming's economy, custom, culture, 8 management of natural resources within Wyoming by proposed 9 policies and decisions by federal agencies involving federal 10 management policies. The 11 resource natural legislature desires to coordinate, cooperate and communicate 12 with the federal government and, if necessary, challenge 13 14 federal natural resource management policies which are implemented or advanced in contravention of decisions made 15 16 by the United States congress or are contrary to the best 17 interests of the state of Wyoming, its local governments and 18 the property rights of its citizens.

Section 3. There is appropriated from the statutory reserve account to the governor's economic stability for federal natural resource policy account one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000.00) to implement the purposes of this act.
