7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

8 Section 1. W.S. 23.1-25(c) and 23.1-33 by creating a  
9 new subsection (e) are amended to read:

10 23.1-25. Limitation of number of big or trophy game  
11 animal licenses; only one moose, one grizzly bear, one  
12 mountain goat or one bighorn sheep license in any  
13 five-year period; reservation of mountain goat and grizzly  
14 bear licenses.

15 (c) The commission shall reserve ~~80%--of--the--moose~~  
16 and SEVENTY-FIVE PERCENT (75%) of the bighorn-sheep

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1 mountain goat, and grizzly bear licenses to be issued in  
2 any one ~~(1)~~ year for resident hunters.

3 23.1-33. Fees; restrictions.

4 ~~(e)~~ THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT ISSUE ANY NONRESIDENT  
5 LICENSES FOR THE HUNTING OF BIGHORN SHEEP OR MOOSE.

6 Section 2. W.S. 23.1-33(b)(vi) and (x) are repealed.

7 Section 3. This act is effective May 27, 1977.


