6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

7 Section 1. W.S. 42-66(b)(x) and (xii) is amended to
8 read:

9 42-66. 'Definitions. As used in this act:

10 (b) "Medical assistance" means payment to providers
11 of part or all of the ordinary and reasonable charges of
12 the following services and supplies for qualified indi-
13 viduals and families:

14 (x) Prosthetic devices made necessary by pre-
15 vious surgical treatment, ~~excluding~~ INCLUDING dental

1 prostheses;

2 (xii) For those "medically needy" as defined
3 in W.S. 42-66(c) ~~who are under twenty-one (21) years of~~
4 ~~age,~~ the professional services of a licensed dentist, ~~and~~
5 eyeglasses, and hearing aids with appropriate testing;

6 Section 2. Two hundred thousand dollars
7 (\$200,000.00) is appropriated from the general fund to the
8 department of health and social services for the fiscal
9 year commencing July 1, 1977 for the purpose of this act.

10 Section 3. This act is effective May 27, 1977.
