A BILL

for

1 AN ACT to amend W.S. 9-7-901(a) introductory paragraph and
2 39-6-411(b)(i) and (ii) and by creating a new subsection
3 (c) relating to sales tax and federal royalties; increas-
4 ing state shared sales tax revenues to local governments
5 to 2/3; providing qualifications; providing for reimburse-
6 ment of lost revenues to the general fund from federal
7 royalty payments; and providing for an effective date.

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

9 Section 1. W.S. 9-7-901(a) introductory paragraph
10 and 39-6-411(b)(i) and (ii) and by creating a new subsec-

1 tion (c) are amended to read:

2 9-7-901. Distribution and use of federal government
3 royalties.

4 (a) All monies received by the state of Wyoming from
5 the secretary of the treasury of the United States under
6 the provisions of the act of congress of February 25, 1920
7 (41 Stat. 437, 450; 30 U.S.C. 181, 191), as amended,
8 except as provided by subsection (b) of this section,
9 shall be deposited in the trust and agency fund, ~~and~~ THE
10 AMOUNT OF REVENUE EQUIVALENT TO THE AMOUNT OF REVENUE
11 GENERATED FROM ONE-THIRD (1/3) OF THE STATE SALES TAX
12 UNDER W.S. 39-6-404 FOR THE PRECEDING FISCAL YEAR SHALL BE
13 TRANSFERRED INTO THE GENERAL FUND TO PARTIALLY REIMBURSE
14 THE GENERAL FUND FOR AID GIVEN TO COUNTIES, CITIES AND
15 TOWNS UNDER W.S. 39-6-411(b) AND (c). THE BALANCE shall
16 be distributed by the state treasurer as follows:

17 39-6-411. Distribution of sales tax to general fund,
18 counties, cities and towns; deduction for administrative
19 costs.

20 (b) Revenue collected by the board under W.S.
21 39-6-404 shall be transferred to the state treasurer who
22 shall:

1 (i) Credit ~~two-thirds~~ ONE-HALF (1/2) to the
2 state general fund THROUGH JUNE 30, 1982 AND ONE-THIRD
3 (1/3) TO THE STATE GENERAL FUND THEREAFTER AND ONE-SIXTH
4 (1/6) TO THE TRUST AND AGENCY FUND EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1982;

5 (ii) Deduct one percent (1%) from the remain-
6 ~~ing--one-third~~ REMAINDER to cover all administrative
7 expenses and costs attributable to the ~~one-third-share~~
8 REMAINDER and credit the general fund for that amount;

9 (c) THE REVENUE CREDITED TO THE TRUST AND AGENCY
10 FUND UNDER PARAGRAPH (b)(i) OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE DIS-
11 TRIBUTED MONTHLY TO COUNTIES, CITIES AND TOWNS WHICH ARE
12 IMPOSING THE ONE CENT (\$.01) OPTIONAL SALES TAX AND WHICH
13 IMPOSED THE MAXIMUM PROPERTY TAX LEVY, EITHER TWELVE (12)
14 OR EIGHT (8) MILLS AS THE CASE MAY BE, DURING THE CURRENT
15 FISCAL YEAR, EACH QUALIFYING COUNTY TO RECEIVE AN AMOUNT
16 IN THE PROPORTION WHICH THE POPULATION OF THE COUNTY OUT-
17 SIDE THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF ANY CITY OR TOWN BEARS TO THE
18 POPULATION OF ALL QUALIFYING COUNTIES, CITIES AND TOWNS
19 AND EACH QUALIFYING CITY OR TOWN TO RECEIVE AN AMOUNT IN
20 THE PROPORTION WHICH THE POPULATION OF THE CITY OR TOWN
21 BEARS TO THE POPULATION OF ALL QUALIFYING COUNTIES, CITIES
22 AND TOWNS.

1 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 1981.

2. Distribution of these additional revenues as provided by this bill would have cities, towns and counties receiving funds on the basis of point-of-sale (Pages 2 - 5) for FY 82 and FY 83. This act also provides for special distribution of funds to those cities, towns and counties qualifying under this act (Pages 6-12). This special distribution becomes effective for FY 1983.
