AN ACT to amend and re-enact Section 37-206,
Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1945,
pertaining to the payment and
disposition of fees for examination by
the State Board of Accountancy; and to
provide an effective date of this Act.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

Section 1. That Section 37-206, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1945, be amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

37-206. The board shall charge for each examination and certificate provided for in this Act a fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00). This fee shall be payable by the applicant at the time of filing the application, and shall be made payable to the State Board of Equalization and shall be deposited by the State Board of Equalization in a bank approved by the State Board of Deposits, and after collections have cleared through said bank, the same shall be transferred to the State Treasurer who shall place the same to the credit of the proper accounts. In no case shall the examination fee be refunded, but said applicant may be re-examined within eighteen (18) months from the date of his application without payment of an additional fee.

Section 2. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 1957.

AN ACT to amend and re-enact Section 37-206, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1955, pertaining to the payment and disposition of fees for examination by the State Board of Accountancy; and to provide an effective date of this Act.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:
I hereby certify that this Act originated in the House.

Section 1. That Section 37-206, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1955, be amended and re-enacted to read as follows:
37-206. The fee shall be payable by the applicant at the time of filing the application, and shall be made payable to the State Board of Accountancy and shall be deposited by the State Board of Accountancy in a bank approved by the State Board of Deposits, and after collection have cleared through said bank, the same shall be transferred to the State Treasurer who shall place the same to the credit of the proper accounts. In no case shall the examination fee be refunded, but said applicant may be re-examined within eighteen (18) months from the date of his application without payment of an additional fee.
Section 2. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 1956.
