A BILL

for

1 AN ACT to amend W.S. 39-6-411(b)(iii) relating to sales
2 tax; providing the revenue share to the counties on sales
3 of motor vehicles, house trailers, trailer coaches, trail-
4 ers or semitrailers shall be distributed to county of ini-
5 tial registration rather than point of sale; and providing
6 for an effective date.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

8 Section 1. W.S. 39-6-411(b)(iii) is amended to read:

9 39-6-411. Distribution of sales tax to general fund,
10 counties, cities and towns; deduction for administrative
11 costs.

12 (b) Revenue collected by the board under W.S.
13 39-6-404 shall be transferred to the state treasurer who
14 shall:

15 (iii) ~~The balance shall then be paid~~ Monthly

1 DISTRIBUTE THE BALANCE to the treasurers of the counties,
2 cities and towns for payment into their respective general
3 funds. THE BALANCE ATTRIBUTABLE TO SALES TAX PAID ON TAX-
4 ABLE SALES OF MOTOR VEHICLES, HOUSE TRAILERS, TRAILER
5 COACHES, TRAILERS OR SEMITRAILERS IS DEEMED ATTRIBUTABLE
6 TO THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE VEHICLE IS INITIALLY REGIS-
7 TERED. The percentage of the balance that will be dis-
8 tributed to each county and its cities and towns will be
9 determined by computing the percentage that net sales
10 taxes collected attributable to vendors in each county
11 including its cities and towns bear to total net sales
12 taxes collected of vendors in all counties including their
13 cities and towns. This percentage of the balance shall be
14 distributed within each county as follows:

15 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 1978.


