

**INSTRUCTING SECRETARY OF STATE TO PROCURE  
INFORMATION AS TO AMOUNT OF BOUNTY  
PAID ON PREDATORY WILD ANIMALS.**

House Joint Resolution No. 3.

*Resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:*

That the Hon. Secretary of State be and is hereby requested to ascertain by mail communication with the County Clerks of each county in the State: Secretary shall communicate with county clerks.

The amounts of money paid, or certificates for money issued, for bounty on predatory wild animals in each county of the State for the year 1894. Said reports to specify: Regarding certificates issued under bounty law.

First—The amounts paid or obligated for bounty on wolves. Amount for wolves.

Second—The amounts on coyotes. For coyotes.

Third—The amounts on mountain lions, and that said information be furnished as soon as practicable. For mountain lions.
