**A BILL**  
for

1 AN ACT relating to the offense of aiding, assisting or accomplish-  
2 ing the escape from lawful custody of a person charged with  
3 or convicted of a misdemeanor; providing a penalty; and repeal-  
4 ing sections 6-163 and 6-166, Wyoming Statutes 1957, relating  
5 to aiding an escape and providing a penalty.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

7 Section 1. Whoever shall knowingly aid, assist or accomplish  
8 the escape or the attempted escape from lawful custody or confine-  
9 ment of any person charged with or convicted of a misdemeanor or  
10 the offense of bastardy, or any juvenile offense; or whoever,  
11 being responsible by law for the custody or confinement of any  
12 person so charged or convicted, shall voluntarily or negligently  
13 suffer or permit such person to escape from his custody, or con-  
14 finement shall be fined not less than one hundred (\$100.00) nor  
15 more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), or imprisoned in the  
16 county jail not to exceed one (1) year, or by both such fine and  
17 imprisonment. Whoever knowingly harbors, conceals or assists any  
18 person charged with or convicted of a misdemeanor, or the offense  
19 of bastardy, or any juvenile offense, who has escaped from lawful  
20 custody, shall be considered as aiding and assisting in the escape,  
21 and shall be subject to the penalty herein provided.

22 Section 2. Sections 6-163 and 6-166, Wyoming Statutes 1957,  
23 are hereby repealed.
