1 AN ACT to amend section 35-439 of the statutes relating to
2 authorizing fire protection districts to promulgate rules

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

7 Section 1. Section 35-439 of the statutes is amended
8 to read:

9 35-439. Powers and duties of board of directors
10 generally; administration of finances; assessment and levy
11 of taxes.

12 (a) The board of directors of any fire protection
13 district is hereby authorized:

14 (i) To enact such ordinances as may be
15 necessary to establish and operate a
16 fire department;

17 (ii) TO PROMULATE ANY RULES AND REGULATIONS

1 AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO EFFECTIVELY ABATE
2 ANY FIRE OR SAFETY HAZARD, OR CONDITIONS
3 WHICH MAY CREATE A FIRE OR SAFETY HAZARD
4 IN ANY BUILDING OR PREMISES IN ANY POR-
5 TION OF THE DISTRICT OUTSIDE THE LIMITS
6 OF CITIES AND TOWNS. IN NO CASE, HOW-
7 EVER, SHALL ANY RULES AND REGULATIONS SO
8 ADOPTED OR PROMULGATED BE LESS STRINGENT
9 THAN THE STANDARDS OF PREVENTION AND
10 SAFETY PROMULGATED BY THE STATE FIRE
11 MARSHAL OR THE STATE;

12 (iii) TO ESTABLISH AS A UNIT OF THE FIRE
13 DEPARTMENT, A FIRE PREVENTION BUREAU TO:

14 (A) ENFORCE RULES AND REGULATIONS
15 ADOPTED PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH
16 (ii) OF THIS SUBSECTION; AND

17 (B) CREATE A PUBLIC AWARENESS OF THE
18 CONDITIONS LEADING TO FIRE AND
19 LOSS OF LIFE THROUGH THE PREPARA-
20 TION AND PRESENTATION OF PUBLIC
21 EDUCATION AND FIRE PREVENTION PRO-
22 GRAMS.

23 (b) The board of directors of fire protection dis-
24 tricts shall administer the finances of such districts

1 according to the provisions of the Wyoming Municipal
2 Budget Act. The assessor shall, at the time of making the
3 annual assessment of his county, also assess the property
4 of each fire protection district in his county and return
5 to the county assessor at the time of returning the
6 assessment schedules, separate schedules listing the prop-
7 erty of each such district assessed by him. Said separate
8 schedule shall be compiled by the county assessor, footed,
9 and returned to the board of county commissioners as pro-
10 vided for other assessment schedules.

11 ~~(b)~~ (c) The board of county commissioners, at
12 the time of making the levy for county purposes shall levy
13 a tax for the year upon the taxable property in such dis-
14 trict in its county for its proportionate share based on
15 assessed valuation of the estimated amounts of funds
16 needed by each such district, but in no case shall the tax
17 for each such district exceed in any one year the amount
18 of three ~~(3)~~ mills on each dollar of assessed valuation of
19 such property. The taxes and assessments of all fire pro-
20 tection districts shall be collected by the county collec-
21 tor at the same time and in the same manner as state and
22 county taxes are collected. ~~7-provided-however,--said~~ THE
23 assessment and tax levied under the provisions of ~~this-act~~
24 SECTIONS 35-437 THROUGH 35-448 shall not be construed as
25 being a part of the general county mill levy.



7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

13 (a) The board of directors of any fire protection
14 district is hereby authorized:
