AN ACT to amend and re-enact Section 109-1420, Revised Statutes of Wyoming, 1931, as amended and re-enacted by Chapter 103, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1933, and by Chapter 83, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1937, relating to the compensation of the Deputy State Superintendent of Public Instruction.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

Section 1. That Section 109-1420, Revised Statutes of Wyoming, 1931, as amended by Chapter 103, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1933, and by Chapter 83, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1937, be amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

Section 109-1420. The deputy state superintendent of public instruction shall receive a salary of * * * THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (~~\$3000.00~~) per annum, payable in equal monthly installments upon vouchers submitted in proper form to the state auditor and in the same manner that other accounts against the State are paid, and shall receive no other compensation for any service rendered by him to the State.

Section 2. This Act shall take effect and be in force upon and after April 1, 1939.
