1 AN ACT to amend and re-enact Section 6-111, Wyoming Statutes  
 2 1957, making it unlawful to incite, advocate or encourage  
 3 crime as a means of coercion or for accomplishing political,  
 4 industrial or administrative reform; providing a penalty  
 5 therefor; and providing that any person complained against  
 6 or indicted for such conduct shall be subject to peace pro-  
 7 ceedings for prevention of crime.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

9 Section 1. That Section 6-111, Wyoming Statutes 1957, be  
 10 amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

11 Whoever in any manner or by any means incites, ~~advises~~, ad-  
 12 vocates, ~~suggests~~ or encourages CRIMINAL TRESPASS, crime OR ANY  
 13 CRIMINAL ACT as a means of coercion or for the accomplishment of  
 14 any political, ~~or~~ industrial OR ADMINISTRATIVE reform, change or  
 15 purpose in this state or in any foreign state or country, whether  
 16 action may follow such incitement or not, shall be deemed guilty  
 17 of incitement to crime and shall be punished by a fine not ex-  
 18 ceeding five thousand dollars (\$5000.00), or by imprisonment in  
 19 the penitentiary not exceeding five (5) years, or by both such fine  
 20 and imprisonment. Any person who shall be ~~guilty of~~ COMPLAINED  
 21 AGAINST OR INDICTED FOR conduct described in this section shall

1 be subject to peace proceedings for the prevention of crime AS  
2 PROVIDED IN SECTIONS 7-58 TO 7-69, WYOMING STATUTES 1957, and  
3 may be proceeded against upon complaint in writing by any  
4 persons having knowledge of the facts, and required to give  
5 security for good behavior or be committed in default of such  
6 recognizance. THE PEACE COMPLAINT NEED NOT ALLEGE OR SHOW  
7 CAUSE FOR COMPLAINANT TO FEAR THE COMMISSION OF AN OFFENSE  
8 AGAINST THE PERSON OR PROPERTY OF HIMSELF, HIS WARD OR CHILD.
