TRANSIENT MERCHANTS - LICENSES.

AN ACT to amend and re-enact Section 3459 Wyoming Compiled Statutes 1920, relating to exceptions to the provisions of said Chapter.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

Section 1. That Section 3459 Wyoming Compiled Statutes 1920 be amended and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Section 3459. EXCEPTIONS. The provisions of this chapter shall not apply to sales made to dealers by commercial travelers selling in the usual course of business or to sheriffs, constables, bona fide assignees, receivers or trustees in bankruptcy, or other public officers selling goods, wares and merchandise according to law, nor to any person selling fruits, vegetables, dressed meats or farm products nor to the selling from wagons of chickens and stock foods, by a bona fide resident of this state.

Section 2. All Acts or parts of Acts in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
