**Original House Bill No. 4**

**STATE MILITARY BOARD AUTHORIZED TO SELL CODY ARMORY**

**AN ACT** authorizing the State Military Board to sell the Cody Armory; and providing for disposition of monies received.

*Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

**Authority To Sell—Legal Description of Grounds**

**Section 1.** The State Military Board is hereby authorized to sell the National Guard buildings and grounds located at Cody, in Park County, Wyoming and more particularly described as follows: Commencing at a point on the North line of Shoshone Avenue (now Wyoming Avenue) of the Town of Cody which is 52.70 feet East

of the Northeast corner of Lot 6, Block 1, in the First Addition to the said Town, (according to the recorded plat thereof), said point of beginning being also at the Southwest corner of a tract of land conveyed by said Lincoln Land Company to Joe Freeborg by deed dated March 3rd, 1941; thence West, along said North line of Shoshone Avenue (now Wyoming Avenue), and along the north line of Lot 6, in Block 1, in the First Addition to said Town, and along the North line of a tract of land conveyed by said Lincoln Land Company to John H. Vogel by deed dated August 13th, 1929, 420.27 feet to the Northwest corner of said John H. Vogel tract; thence south at right angles thereto 210 feet, to intersect the North line of the Alley of Block 1 of said First Addition; thence West, in the continuation West of the North line of said Alley, to intersect the Westerly line of a tract of land conveyed by said Lincoln Land Company to Agnes B. Chamberlin by deed dated July 10th, 1929, if said Westerly line were produced North; thence Southwesterly, along said Westerly extended line to intersect the South line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 32, in Township 53, North, of Range 101 West of the 6th P. M.; thence West along said South line to the Southwest corner of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ; thence North along the West line of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  350 feet; thence east at right angles to the West line of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  to intersect the center line of the travelled road running across said NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ; thence North 57° 22' East along said center line of road to the Northwest corner of the tract of land conveyed by said Lincoln Land Company to Joe Freeborg as aforesaid; thence South 22° 05' East along the Westerly side of said Joe Freeborg tract 179.20 feet to the place of beginning.

**Section 2.** All monies received from such sale shall be deposited with the State Treasurer for the General Fund.
