AN ACT to amend and re-enact Section 1047 of the Revised Statutes of Wyoming, defining offences by cheats, swindlers and others .

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING :

Section 1.- That Section 1047 of the Revised Statutes of Wyoming be amended and re-enacted to read as follows; If any person shall knowingly sell by false weights or measures , or shall knowingly use false measures at any ^{or threshing} threshing machine , or at any mill , in taking toll for grinding ^{and seeds} corn, wheat, rye or other grain, he shall be deemed a common cheat, and, on conviction, shall be fined not less than two hundred dollars, and be imprisoned in the county jail not exceeding three months .

Section 2.- This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage .
