SCHEDULE A

Trade mark has been used on and/or is intended principally for structural insulating slabs and steel members, and other construction materials.

Trade mark is also intended for every attachment, appurtenance, supply, part, device, tool, accessory, machine or part of a machine used in manufacture, use, sale, application, transportation, distribution or storage of any of the foregoing; and upon all present or future, scientific, patented or other improvements on any of the foregoing; also on prints, publications, pamphlets, circulars, invoices, letters, letterheads, premiums, tokens, facsimile letters, advertising, advertising copy, materials, mailing lists, bill heads, envelopes, order blanks, safety paper, all vouchers of value and the like, containers, dispensers, jackets, bags, cartons, and corrugated cartons, receptacles, bottles, boxes, calendars, advertising novelties, material in sheet form composed or consisting of parchment, plastic, cellophane, wood, paper or paper and textile combined, and for use in wrapping, packing and lining, or for covers or containers for merchandise and articles of the foregoing manufacture and like purposes.

While the foregoing list mentions specific articles, Applicant's right, title and interest in and to said trade mark, whether derived from this registration or otherwise acquired, are not to be construed as limited to the articles specified; but all other articles of the same general class or classes are hereby reserved and included; whether the mark appears individually on specific parts, or on combination of parts, or service and maintenance connected therewith. The right is further claimed for the trade mark as a property by reason of use and this instrumentality; and the further right is reserved to Applicant for other classes of products, merchandise and materials of every description and advertising and service connected therewith for trade mark purposes.

Claim is made for the essential feature of the trade mark comprising the arbitrarily selected word "THERMAX".

Claim is made to use the word "THERMAX" comprising the essential feature of the trade mark, alone, or in any other arrangement, and claim is made for words which are assonant, paragogic or onomatopoeic thereto. Claim is made whereby the size of the lettering shown on the facsimile, the color indicated therein, the style of lettering, ornamentation, symbol or illustration, may be amended, modified or varied in association with the said trade mark or any of the component parts thereof.
