### A BILL

for

1 AN ACT to amend W.S. 9-3-101(a) relating to salaries of  
 2 elected state officials and judges of the supreme and dis-  
 3 trict courts; increasing salaries; providing for an appro-  
 4 priation; and providing for an effective date.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

6 Section 1. W.S. 9-3-101(a) is amended to read:

7 9-3-101. Salaries; amount; date of payment.

8 (a) Salaries for clerk of the supreme court and dis-  
 9 trict court reporters shall be determined by the supreme

1 court as authorized by legislative appropriations. Subject  
2 to constitutional limitations the following state officers  
3 and members of the judiciary shall receive the salaries  
4 indicated by the figures following their respective  
5 titles:

7	(ii) Secretary of state	<del>\$52,500.00</del>	<u>\$62,500.00</u>

15 Section 2. There is appropriated from the general  
16 fund to the state treasurer the sum of two hundred  
17 seventy-two thousand eight hundred dollars (\$272,800.00)  
18 or as much thereof as may be necessary to pay the salaries  
19 herein authorized when permitted under constitutional lim-  
20 itations.

1           Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 1985.
