for

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION relating to travel and tourism; sup-
 2 porting the upgrade and use of United States Highway 85 as
 3 an alternate route to the Heartland Express.

4 WHEREAS, the Heartland Express, a four-lane road to
 5 connect Rapid City, South Dakota and Denver, Colorado
 6 through Scottsbluff, Nebraska has been planned for several
 7 years, and the corridor feasibility study is currently in
 8 progress; and

9 WHEREAS, the legislation authorizing the Heartland
 10 Express was sponsored by the South Dakota and Nebraska
 11 Congressional Delegations, and has the support of a coali-
 12 tion of mayors from communities in South Dakota, Western

1 Nebraska and Colorado; and

2 WHEREAS, the new highway, the Heartland Express, will
3 be parallel to existing United States Highway 85, a pri-
4 mary highway that is in some places within thirty (30)
5 miles proximity of the proposed Heartland Express; and

6 WHEREAS, United States Highway 85 is designated a
7 CanAm Highway connecting Texas and Canada; and

8 WHEREAS, the enhancement of existing United States
9 Highway 85 as a direct route between Denver and Rapid City
10 would be a more fiscally responsible use of federal tax
11 dollars; and

12 WHEREAS, the completion of the proposed expressway has
13 the potential to divert a large percentage of the traffic
14 currently using United States Highway 85; and

15 WHEREAS, the current and future traffic on United
16 States Highway 85 is critical to the economy of eastern
17 Wyoming.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE LEG-
19 ISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

20 Section 1. The members of the Wyoming Legislature

1 support the goal and work of the Highway 85 Coalition to
2 promote United States Highway 85 as the most direct route
3 between Denver, Colorado and Rapid City, South Dakota.

4 Section 2. The members of the Wyoming Legislature
5 strongly encourage the Wyoming Congressional Delegation,
6 the Governor, the Wyoming Department of Transportation and
7 the Wyoming Division of Tourism and State Marketing to
8 upgrade and actively promote United States Highway 85 as
9 an alternate route to the Heartland Express.

10 Section 3. That copies of this resolution shall be
11 transmitted to the Wyoming Congressional Delegation, the
12 Governor of Wyoming, the Director of the Department of
13 Transportation and the Administrator of the Wyoming Divi-
14 sion of Tourism and State Marketing.


