NOTICE OF APPLICATION
(Issued August 16, 2022)

Pursuant to the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act and the Wyoming Public Service Commission (Commission) Rules, the Commission hereby gives notice that Water Unlimited Inc., (Water Unlimited) and Hurricane Services 21, LLC, (Hurricane) (Collectively the Companies) submitted a joint application requesting authority to transfer controlling ownership interest in Water Unlimited to Hurricane, pursuant to the provisions of Wyo. Stat. § 37-1-104 and Commission Rule Chapter 3, Section 21(f).

1. On August 1, 2022, the Companies filed their Application requesting Commission authority to transfer ownership interest in Water Unlimited to Hurricane. Water Unlimited operates a privately-owned artesian well east of the town of Newcastle in Weston County, Wyoming. Hurricane is a Wyoming LLC, who, through its affiliate, Black Hills Plumbing, operates three water service districts in Weston County; the Salt Creek, Osage and Westend Water Districts.

2. The Companies propose the transfer of all issued and outstanding shares from Elizabeth Field, Cary Voss, Connie Reimer, and Thomas Voss to Hurricane, who will become the sole shareholder and controlling owner of the utility. The Companies aver that the proposed transfer will not negatively impact any other utility or the provision of utility service to customers. If approved, the Companies state Hurricane intends to upgrade the distribution system infrastructure to improve service reliability. The Companies state Hurricane intends to finance the necessary system improvements but may seek the Commission's approval to increase customer's rates in the future to recover a portion of the improvement costs.

A proposed intervention or request for hearing must set forth the grounds and the position and interest of the petitioner in this proceeding.
