8 Section 1. W. S. 21-4-310 is created to read:

- 10 21-4-310. Reporting of unlawful activity to law
- 11 enforcement by school personnel.

- 13 (a) Any principal, teacher or other school employee
- 14 who has knowledge of any unlawful activity as defined in
- 15 subsection (c) of this section which occurred or may have
- 16 occurred on school property shall report such activity to
- 17 the superintendent of the school district or his designee
- 18 who shall notify the appropriate law enforcement officials

- 1 as required by this section. In the event of an emergency
- 2 or if the superintendent or his designee is unavailable, any
- 3 principal may make a report required under this subsection.

- 5 (b) When the superintendent or his designee has a
- 6 reasonable belief that an act has occurred on educational
- 7 property or during a school related activity involving any
