6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

7 Section 1. W.S. 33-355.5(a), (b), (c) and (d) are 8 amended to read:

<u>33-355.5. Wyoming real estate commission: disposi-</u>
 <u>tion of fees.</u>

11 (a) There--is-hereby-created Ihe Wyoming real estate 12 commission IS CREATED, hereinafter referred to as the 13 "commission", to consist of the-commissioner-of-agricul-14 ture-who-shall-act-as-commissioner-of-real-estate--without 15 additional--compensation--and three (3) members, each of 16 whom shall be a citizen of this state and shall have been

1 engaged in business as an active broker in this state for at least five (5) continuous years prior to the date of 2 appointment and no more than one (1) of whom shall be 3 his residents of the same county. The members of the commis-4 5 sion--shall-be-appointed-by-the-governor-within-sixty-(60) 6 days-after-the-effective-date--of--this--act--33-355.1--to 7 33-355+17+---Initial-appointments-shall-bet-one-(1)-member 8 for-one-(1)-years-one-(1)-members-for-two-(2)--years--and 9 one--(1)-member-for-three-(3)-years. The term of the mem-10 bers of the commission shall be for three (3) years and 11 until their successors are appointed and gualified. Each 12 appointee, before entering the duties of his office shall take and-subscribe the constitutional oath of office which 13 14 shall be filed with the secretary of state. Members 15 appointed to fill vacancies shall be appointed to succeed 16 himself for more than one (1) full term. Upon the gual-17 ifications of the members appointed, the commission shall 18 organize by selecting from its members a chairman and may do all things necessary and-proper for carrying out the 19 20 provisions of this act and mayy-from-time-to-timey-promul-21 gate--and--amend--necessary-and-reasonable ISSUE rules and 22 regulations. for-such-purposes.

(b) For administrative purposes only, the commission
shall be a division of the department of agriculture under

1 the-direction-and-supervision-of-the-commissioner-of-agri2 culture.

3 (c) The commission may WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE 4 COMMISSIONER OF AGRICULTURE employ a director or a desig-5 nated representative to serve as director of the division 6 of real estate. Such THE director or designated repre-7 sentative will be subject to the rules and regulations of 8 the Wyoming personnel commission and shall be paid from the account within the earmarked revenue fund. The duties 9 10 of the director shall include the following:

11 (i) To <u>Maintain</u> and operate a suitable office 12 for the commission<u>:</u>

13 (ii) To Keep books, records, and accounts of
14 all activities of the commission:

15 (iii) To <u>I</u>ssue real estate broker and/or OR
 16 salesman licenses<u>i</u>

(iv) To Make investigations of complaints and
possible violations of the real estate laws and practices
of licensees and to furnish information obtained to the
commission for their actionim

(v) To <u>A</u>ssist the commission with examinations
 to be given applicants for real estate broker and salesman

licenses; and to conduct such examinations at the direc tion of the commission<u>i</u>*

3 (vi) To <u>Have</u> charge of the preparation of
4 material to be published in news bulletins to be issued
5 from time to time and mailed to licensees:

(vii) To Assist the commission in holding
educational clinics or meetings when deemed advisable with
the aim of promoting higher standards of practice in the
real estate profession:

10 (viii) To Perform such other duties as the
11 commission prescribes.

12 (d) The commission shall employ such other employees as it shall deem necessary to assist in the discharge of 13 the duties imposed upon-it by this act and shall prescribe 14 15 the duties and fix the compensation of its employees, 16 subject to the general laws of the state. The office of 17 the commission shall be maintained in the office of the 18 commissioner DEPARTMENT of agriculture at Cheyenne and all 19 files, records and property of the commission shall at all 20 times remain therein. No employee of the commission may 21 be a paid employee of any real estate association or group 22 of real estate dealers or brokers.
