1 A JOINT RESOLUTION requesting the Congress of the United  
 2 States to propose an amendment to the Constitution of the  
 3 United States for ratification by the several States,  
 4 either by their Legislatures or in convention called for  
 5 that purpose, relative to the right to human life.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING,  
 7 a majority of all members of the two houses, voting sepa-  
 8 rately, concurring herein:

9 That the Congress of the United States is hereby  
 10 memorialized and urged to propose a Human Life Amendment  
 11 to the Constitution of the United States for ratification  
 12 by the Legislatures of the several States or in convention  
 13 called for that purpose, providing substantially as fol-  
 14 lows:

15 1. That from conception until death each human  
 16 individual is a "person" entitled under the 5th and 14th

1 Amendments to the Constitution of the United States to  
2 protection against deprivation of life without due process  
3 of law.

4 2. That Congress and the Legislatures of the  
5 several States shall have concurrent power to enforce the  
6 provisions of the Amendment by appropriate legislation.

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF  
8 WYOMING:

9 That if the Congress of the United States fails to  
10 enact a Human Life Amendment to the United States Con-  
11 stitution, providing substantially as aforesaid, for sub-  
12 mission to the several States for ratification within two  
13 (2) years from the date of final passage of this Resolu-  
14 tion, then the Congress be and hereby is requested to call  
15 a Constitutional Convention for the purpose of proposing  
16 such a Human Life Amendment to the Constitution of the  
17 United States providing substantially as aforesaid; and

18 That certified copies of this Resolution be trans-  
19 mitted by the Secretary of State of Wyoming to the Presi-  
20 dent of the United States, the President of the Senate and  
21 the Speaker of the House of Representatives of the United  
22 States, the Senators and Representative representing  
23 Wyoming in the Congress of the United States, and the mem-
